



SGH Case Study: Wet Gas Play - Ontario



SGH can be used for petroleum exploration. Although the SGH signature for petroleum is different than that for mineral targets, the geochromatography is the same. This transect of B-horizon soil samples, taken in February and March of 2005, was taken along the road right-of-way. There was no interference to the SGH data from activity on this paved road.



A second case study again showed excellent agreement with the location of a nearby gas well. Samples were taken from the road right-of-way for this client by Actlabs' personnel. The SGH signature contained light aromatic compounds that was consistent with the condensate of this "wet gas" play.
